



How do you get rid of fleas in home?

The best way to get rid of fleas (Siphonaptera) is an integrated approach which first treats any pets in your household and then your house itself. Household flea control begins with treating the animal, then treating the house. Both steps have to be done and they have to be done together. At least the pet should be the first treated.

PET TREATMENT:

The pet(s) must be treated first before you can hope to rid the house (carpeting) of fleas. The pet's bedding should be washed or replaced when the pet is treated. There are some very effective on-animal flea control products. Some are available from the veterinarian and some are over-the-counter products.

HOUSE TREATMENT:

Vacuuming the carpet helps to remove the eggs that drop there. Vacuuming will remove a few larvae and the debris that the larvae eat. Vacuuming will cause the adult fleas to come out of their cocoons while the carpet treatment is fresh and effective.

Continue to vacuum for 14 days after the carpet has been treated. It is normal to see fleas for a couple of weeks after the treatment. Make sure you remove and discard the bag or canister from the vacuum cleaner every time you do this. Discard the bag or contents of the canister outside the home.

Some outdoors treatments may be necessary, including kennels where the animals may be kept. Make sure you keep your lawn cut short.

COST FOR TREATMENT:

First Treatment Costs: \$150, extra for dog run, and required 14 day follow-up at \$98
